#### **Application Process**

All scholarship applicants must:

- » Please type application
- » Submit the official HBC scholarship application form found on page 3.
- » Include a copy of the most recent student transcript. Unofficial copies are accepted.
- » Plan to enroll in residential construction trades or a related field (i.e., plumbing, electrical, building construction technology, construction management, heating/air conditioning, etc.) at Minnesota State Community and Technical College (M State) in Moorhead or North Dakota State College of Science (NDSCS) in Wahpeton within eighteen (18) months of graduation.
- » Provide two letters of recommendation. The letters should be mailed separately to the Home Builders Care of Fargo-Moorhead Foundation, 1802 32nd Ave. S., Fargo, ND 58103. Applicants are encouraged to include letters from sources outside of their high school.
- » Include a brief desciption of financial situation. This should include financial aid, grants, scholarships, etc., received.
  - Include up to a two-page typewritten statement of the following:
    - 1. Education objectives (both short and long-term).
    - 2. Job shadowing experience (if applicable).
    - 3. Information concerning the applicant's construction work experiences and/or courses related to the construction industry.
    - 4. Any honors or awards received while in high school.
    - 5. Career goals beyond post-secondary education.
    - 6. Description of course(s), experience or individual(s) that have influenced applicant's interest in this career field, and why or how the applicant has been influenced.

#### **Awards**

Scholarship amounts can vary. Depending on the applications, one or more awards may be issued. The awarded funds will be held until the student has graduated from high school and proof of enrollment at M State or NDSCS is provided to Home Builders Care of Fargo-Moorhead Foundation. Proof of enrollment must be provided to HBC within 18 months of graduation or the scholarship will be forfeited.

#### Judging

A scholarship evaluation committee consisting of HBC board trustees, HBA board directors, HBA members and staff, and Student Chapter advisors will determine recipients of scholarship awards based on information in the application packet. Applicants will be evaluated using a point system based on the items shown at right. Applications that do not contain all requested information will not be considered.
